

2017-2018 VOLUNTEER CREDIT

The Figure 8 Skating Club is governed entirely by a volunteer board of directors. Our primary mandate is to create an environment that maximizes the potential for all skaters and provides a positive experience for all members. The success of the Club depends on the volunteer efforts of the members. Volunteering in the club is a great opportunity to learn about the sport of figure skating and how the club runs, as well as a fun way to meet other club members and have a good time while helping out. There are many ways to volunteer in the Club.

It is mandatory for every family to work one shift at the casino on a year that we have a Casino <u>and</u> volunteer 10 credits. The next Casino will be October 6 and 7 2017 at the Argyll Casino.

Every parent of a <u>private Starskater or Introduction to Figure Skating (IFS)</u> may choose to either:

- 1. Donate the \$150 fee at the time of registration, or
- 2. Volunteer for the Club and submit a post dated cheque in the amount of \$150 (Volunteer Deposit post dated cheque for March 1st 2018 cashed only if 10 volunteer credits are not completed during Fall and Winter programs)

A post dated cheque must accompany the skater's registration form in order for their registration to be processed. The \$150 volunteer fee may be earned back by completing 10 credits worth of volunteer service. Credit values for individual tasks are listed below. The volunteer credits must be earned during the Fall and Winter sessions. Email notification will be sent out when volunteers are needed and tasks will be assigned on a first come, first served basis at registration. It is the responsibility of parents to ensure they fulfill the minimum 10 credit requirement if they would like their cheque returned.

If you have more than 1 skater (private and IFS) registered to the Club, you are only asked to work 10 credit.
