*Tip for Skaters and Parents: Don't forget to dry your blades after each session to avoid them getting rusty! Only use soft covers (no hard guards) to put on the blades after skating. This will ensure your blades will stay in good condition and last longer! Also, please make

sure you skaters are wearing CSA certified helmets that are properly fitted and secured.
