#### Awards Banquet Coordinator - Credits - 12 Credits

Organize and coordinate the Awards Banquet and AGM, including coordinating the food and other logistics. Date will be in Fall 2023, to be determined.

## Fundraising Assistant - 12 Credits

Assist the Fundraising Coordinator to research and apply for grants, and/or assist with other fundraising opportunities as they arise, such as helping to organize online raffles (as well as assistance with coordinating casino volunteers in a casino year). Note that there are two volunteers assigned to this role.

## Party Organizer (Winter 1) - 6 Credits

## **Brittany Forsyth**



Hi everyone,

My name is Brittany, and I have been a figure skating coach for 12 years. Currently, I hold a provincial coach-trained certification and have completed the Special Olympics Community Coach certification. This is my first full season with the Figure 8 Skating Club, as I came on board last spring. Before joining Figure 8, I was the Skating Director at the Fort Saskatchewan Skating Club for six years.

My skating journey started very shortly after I was able to walk. I grew up skating in British Columbia, medalled at provincial championships and was fortunate enough to be able to compete at the

Western Divisional Championships (now known as Challenge). I was a recurring member of the BC junior development teams and their junior/senior provincial teams, which allowed me to work with and learn from many high-level coaches. I also spent some time pair skating, which brought a very exciting challenge to my skating. Previously I have coached skaters up to their gold freeskate, Junior Competitive singles and Pre-Juvenile pairs.

When not coaching, I work full-time in Education. I enjoy spending time with my family and have picked up running over the last few years. I have two children, ages 12 and 9, who are also involved in ice sports, so most of my "free time" is still spent in an arena somewhere.
